

## **Ruth E. Halliburton (Macgregor)**

1903 - 1984

***Ruth Eleanor Halliburton nee Macgregor*** (maiden name of Seitz is erroneous). Born in Rainy River, Ontario on 21 January 1903 to Donald McGregor & Mary Thompson. 1930 census info says she was a dental nurse widow who resided with in Toldeo in '30 with her brother, Alpin Roderick Macgregor. A newsclip from 1929 says she had been studying the mechanics of flying for several years and that "Mrs. Halliburton owns a Travel Air biplane."

No further aviation activity is noted and she moved away from the area in by the mid '30s. Ruth was wife to 1) Dr. Benjamin Halliburton (m.1926) who died in 1929. 2) Horace W. Kirkpatrick. In 1940, they were enumerated in Darby, Pennsylvania with their children Mary Ann (four) & Donna (two) and her mother lived with them. Horace died in 1946. In the early '50s Ruth was found in the Monterey, California directory as 'widow of H.W. Kirkpatrick" working as a nurse at the Monterey hospital. Further directories show her in Huntington Beach, California where she died 27 May 1984. (No obituary or grave located as of yet).
